The Cayman Learning Centre approach to tutoring is broken down into four key components:

- ✓ *The Cayman Learning Centre Skills Assessment*
- ✓ *Individualized Program Development*
- ✓ *Program Implementation*
- ✓ *Student Progress Monitoring / Progress Update*

1) The Cayman Learning Centre Skills Assessment – Why is it Important for my Son/Daughter?

The Cayman Learning Centre Skills Assessment is a comprehensive tool testing students' skills in both mathematics and language arts. This assessment tool is critical in allowing us to pinpoint:

- a) the skills the student has mastered and,
- b) the specific areas requiring further attention.

Thus, the Skills Assessment forms the basis for the program development.

2) Individualized Program Development

Following the Skills Assessment, an Individualized Program is created by the Centre Director to focus on your child's specific areas for development. The Cayman Learning Centre's database of educational materials expands over thousands of pages covering skill areas from A through Z in core subject areas for all ages.

3) Program Implementation

Our programs are delivered by highly qualified teachers licensed to teach your child's age group. Furthermore, all of our teachers are passionate about teaching and are dedicated to ensure that your child receives the individualized attention he or she requires to succeed.

4) Student Progress Monitoring & Progress Updates

This process is one the most critical components of our methodology. Unlike a classroom, where the learning pace is dictated by the education curriculum or learning plan, at Cayman Learning Centre your child is in full control of his or her learning development. Only when your child has mastered a specific skill or task, a new skill is introduced. We believe that this process creates a comfortable learning environment while ensuring that your child fully grasps the skills in question prior to moving on to a new skill set. When a skill is mastered, your child will gain a strong sense of accomplishment, building his or her confidence to move forward to a new skill set.

Our teachers are trained to continuously monitor each student's progress and to ensure that each one of our students is continuously challenged in a fun learning environment. As a parent, you will meet with the Centre Director approximately every six weeks to discuss your child's progress to date and his or her current and future learning programs.

Which Learning Program is Appropriate for my Son/Daughter?

1) The Cayman Learning Centre Core Learning Program

The Core Learning Program is designed for students years one through high school.

The classes run in fifty minute sessions starting on the hour. The maximum student to teacher ratio is three to one. The suggested number of weekly sessions for each student varies depending on the student's learning pace and pre-existing knowledge base. In general, we recommend that our students attend a minimum of two weekly sessions in order to facilitate retention and the consolidation of new material.

2) The Cayman Learning Centre Building Blocks Program

The focus of this program is to master the "building blocks" of knowledge in our pre-school students (ages 3-5). The program runs daily in 2.5 hour sessions. The student teacher ratio will not exceed six to one. This program is taught through fun learning activities where your child will learn: colours, shapes, motor skill development, numbers, the alphabet, phonics, along with other basic skills. The young students attending this program will gain important socialization skills as they join their peers at circle time, group activities, snack and craft. Furthermore, the program focuses on building our young students' confidence while fostering a love for learning and getting them ready for a successful academic career.
