# KEYBOARDING Without Tears



## We will coach your child to keyboarding fluency.

This curriculum teaches keyboarding skills in a grade-appropriate and developmentally-based sequence. The focus is on a simplified approach to letter location and learning to use fingers correctly. Activities begin with separate hands. Students begin by building basic finger muscle strength and practice bilateral separation of the left and right hand. Activities are designed to expose students to a variety of fun, intuitive games and that keep them

engaged and expand their knowledge of subjects as they become familiar with the structure and organization of the QWERTY key arrangement through our unique color-coded, row-based teaching method. In the first six weeks, we move through the fundamental six row-based QWERTY sections of the keyboard. From week seven to week 36, the activities teach, test, and develop the student's fluency and proficiency with all the keys.
